<b>Who can apply?</b>	Candidates must be in possession of: a) a five-year or four-year secondary (high) school diploma; b) a secondary (high) school diploma awarded by a foreign upper secondary education institution or school. Through Italian diplomatic representatives abroad, they must arrange and provide the translation, legalisation, and validity declaration of the degree certificate. They are also required to provide a conversion of their final academic score in percentage marks; c) degrees awarded by the Italian Republic, international bachelor's degrees, or diplomas awarded by European schools.
<b>How to apply</b>	Candidates must first register online and fill in the application <b>from 3 to 25 July 2017 (by 03:00 PM)</b> , connecting to <a href="http://www.universitaly.it">www.universitaly.it</a> and selecting Università Iuav di Venezia as the venue for which he intends to compete. <b>By 28 July 2017</b> , all candidates must also pre-register online by connecting to Online Services at <a href="https://iuav.esse3.cineca.it/Start.do">https://iuav.esse3.cineca.it/Start.do</a> They will be required to: -fill out an electronic pre-registration form; -upload a scanned copy of a valid ID as a digital attachment; -insert the registration code they received after their initial registration on the ministerial website <a href="http://www.universitaly.it">www.universitaly.it</a> ; -pay the <b>€ 60.00 admission fee</b> . Non-EU students residing abroad will also have to pre-register through the relevant Italian representative.
<b>Admission test</b>	Modalities and contents of the admission test are determined by the decree of the Italian Ministry of Education, Universities and Research (MIUR) of 28 June 2017 n. 477, which can be downloaded from the Iuav website at <a href="http://www.iuav.it/orientamen/isrules/Come-si-ac/Architettura/index.htm">http://www.iuav.it/orientamen/isrules/Come-si-ac/Architettura/index.htm</a> and at <a href="http://www.iuav.it/orientamen/iscriversi/Come-si-ac/Architettura1/index.htm">http://www.iuav.it/orientamen/iscriversi/Come-si-ac/Architettura1/index.htm</a> The test consists of sixty questions: two in general culture, twenty in logical reasoning, sixteen in history, ten in design and representation, twelve in physics and mathematics.  <b>Non-EU applicants residing abroad</b> will have to take an Italian language test before the ones listed above.
<b>When and where</b>	<b>7 September 2017, 11:00 AM</b> , at the venue of Santa Marta ex Cotonificio Olcese, Dorsoduro 2196 - 30123 Venezia. Candidates must present themselves at the venue <b>one hour beforehand</b> for identification procedures; therefore, they must have a <b>valid ID</b> and the <b>receipt of the initial pre-registration payment</b> and <b>confirmation of their initial registration on the ministerial website <a href="http://www.universitaly.it">www.universitaly.it</a></b> . For the Italian language test, <b>non-EU applicants residing abroad</b> must present themselves at the venue <b>one hour beforehand</b> for identification procedures; they must have their <b>passport with the specific entry visa</b> for "University Enrolment" study purposes.
<b>Final assessment methods</b>	For the assessment of the admission tests to the degree programmes referred to in Art. 1 of the Competition Notice, a maximum of 90 points will be awarded according to the following criteria: 1.5 points for each correct answer; - 0.4 points for each wrong answer; 0 points for each unanswered question. In the case of candidates with the same final score, their score will be broken down into each question category, which rank differently. From highest to lowest: logical reasoning, general culture, history, design and representation, physics and mathematics.  candidates will be further evaluated according to the ranking rankings of the candidate in the order of the ranking rank in the order of the ranking, respectively, the questions related to arguments of logical reasoning, general culture, history, design and representation, physics and mathematics. In case the scores still tie, the

	younger candidate will be given priority.
<b>Admission rankings</b>	On <b>21 September 2017</b> the Secure Web Area of the ministerial website University will exclusively publish the scoring of each candidate, according to their bar code. On <b>29 September 2017</b> , candidates can view their admission test work, their specific scoring, and their personal data, always through the Secure Web Area of the ministerial website University. On <b>3 October 2017</b> , the Secure Web Area of University will publish the <b>national ranking of nominees</b> , both Italian and non but legally residing in Italy.
<b>Fee payment</b>	The candidate who is finally <b>ASSIGNED</b> at luav degree programmes will be required to pre-register <b>from 3 to 6 October 2017</b> , by completing the online procedure through the reserved area of the Online Services, downloading the MAV (Payment Notice Form) and paying the first instalment, which will not exceed € 823.00. The maximum amount of university fees for a.a. 2017/18 is € 2,742.00 (including stamp duty and regional tax for the right to study), divided into 3 instalments.
<b>After the test: matriculation</b>	<p>All admitted candidates must finalise their pre-matriculation <b>from 3 October 2017</b> at Palazzo Badoer, at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Monday to Friday from 9:00 AM to 12:00 (noon);</li> <li>-Tuesday and Thursday from 2:30 PM to 4:30 PM.</li> </ul> <p>They must submit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- dated and signed matriculation application;</li> <li>- MAV receipt of first instalment payment;</li> <li>- copy of ID;</li> <li>- copy of fiscal code.</li> </ul> <p><b>Non-EU applicants residing abroad</b> must also submit a copy of the residence permit (or residence permit application receipt) and the original documentation issued by the Italian representative office they pre-registered in: original diploma certificate (with official translation, legalisation, and validity declaration of the degree certificate), application form for pre-registration (Modello A), photo authentication.</p> <p>Candidates from the Marco Polo programme must also submit language certification.</p> <p>To access the degree programmes referred to in this Competition Notice, an appropriate initial preparation in previous studies is required. <b>Students who enrol but have achieved a less than 40 points</b> in their admission test score - and less than 5 points in the category of "drawing and representation" and/or less than 2 points in "physics and mathematics" -, will be given <b>further training requirements (OFAs)</b> that must be met by passing a specific test before carrying out the actual exam. The non-fulfilment of the additional training obligations by 30 September 2018 will determine the enrolment for the following academic year as a repeating student.</p>
