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

## international workshop

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Innovation is now considered the main drive behind development, and knowledge the necessary premise for innovation. The analysis of connections between knowledge, creativity and innovation, however, remains essentially connected in mainstream economics to a "logic-positivist" approach. While acknowledging the foundational role this approach has in enhancing knowledge, science and technology, increasing evidence raises questions about its suitability for further understanding the complex dynamics it has generated. Further comprehensive (rather than alternative) approaches have been proposed to cope with the issue, among which the evolutionary one has achieved considerable credit in social sciences, and mainly economics. Recent debates contend, however, the appropriateness of this approach itself, by arguing that socio-cultural systems actively concur in shaping their cognitive, creative and innovative evolutionary paths. The workshop aims at examining if a "hermeneutic" approach fits better to explain relationships occurring between knowledge and creativity. Theoretical contributions and a number of empirical investigations on European cities and organisations are presented to examine the heuristic power and consistency of this approach.
