

## Erasmus+ Programme

### Key Action 1 – Mobility for learners and staff – Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility

#### Inter-institutional agreement 2015-2021 between institutions from programme and partner countries

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects of the organization and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits (or equivalent) awarded to students by the partner institution. The institutions also commit to sound and transparent management of funds allocated to them through Erasmus+.

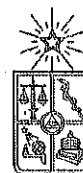
#### A. Objectives of the Agreement

In order to promote the cultural exchange and to enhance undergraduate education of architecture students, the Department of Architecture of the Università IUAV di Venezia and the Faculty of Architecture and Urbanism of the University of Chile sign this agreement. This document aims at establishing an academic protocol for recognizing studies of architecture taught in both institutions.

This program is intended to award a dual degree that allows students from Università IUAV di Venezia to obtain the Diploma of Architecture at the University of Chile and students from University of Chile to obtain the Laurea Magistrale in Architettura degree at Università IUAV di Venezia. This agreement is valid only by accomplishing all national laws and procedure rules from each involved university.

The Laurea Magistrale in Architettura degree awarded by the Università IUAV di Venezia is a programme for advanced academic undergraduate education, which is obtained after the bachelor in architecture degree. It is a 4-semester program taught in Italian, and comprises 120 transferable credits (ECTS).

The Diploma in Architecture awarded by the University of Chile is the professional education programme for students who have finished its bachelor in architecture degree. It is 4-semester program taught in Spanish, and comprises 192 credits according to study plan in force.

**C. Mobility numbers<sup>3</sup> per academic year**

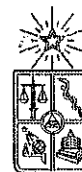
**Students who want to study for the double degree program must arrive in the hosting Institution at the beginning of the academic year.**

In order to obtain a Double Degree, UChile students will have to enroll in and attend the courses of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of one of the *Laurea Magistrale in Architettura* (LM4) degrees active/available at Iuav in the academic year at their arrival.

In order to obtain a Double Degree, Iuav students will have to enrol in the graduation project, in UChile, which should be developed in two semesters. In addition, they will have to enrol in and attend a mandatory seismic structures course and a professional internship for 250 hours during the graduation project period.

Even though the double degree exchange recognizes reciprocity between both institutions, the Laurea Magistrale in Architettura program at IUAV considers a two-semester period for incoming students, but the Professional Diploma of Architecture at UChile considers a regular period of three-semester for exchange students. With the exception of Iuav that awards academic degrees only, the University of Chile has legal authority to award the professional diploma of architecture; then the courses and internship required are mandatory. In order to homologate the exchange period, the professional diploma program at Uchile should be developed in two semesters. Only for exceptional cases, the professional internship can be taken in the summer semester just before the first graduation project semester; or just after the second graduation project semester, during the summer semester of the next year.

## Workshop Mobility

The parties can cooperate in organizing common didactic workshops (upon mutual consent) where participants, students and teachers can come/go from/to Università Iuav di Venezia and/or from/to Universidad de Chile. The coordinators will be responsible for the organization and the number of participants of the common workshops and for the number of credits accumulated by students.

### D. Recommended language skills

The sending institution, following the agreement with the receiving institution, is responsible for providing support to its nominated candidates so that they can have the recommended language skills at the start of the study or teaching period.

Before the arrival of the incoming students, the receiving institutions will inform the incoming students about language courses offered before their arrival and/or during their stays.

### E. Respect of fundamental principles and other mobility requirements

The higher education institution agrees to:

- Respect in full the principles of non-discrimination and to promote and ensure equal access and opportunities to mobile participants from all backgrounds, in particular disadvantaged or vulnerable

groups.

- Apply a selection process that is fair, transparent and documented, ensuring equal opportunities to participants eligible for mobility.
- Ensure recognition for satisfactorily completed activities of study mobility and, where possible, internships of its mobile students.
- Charge no fees, in the case of credit mobility, to incoming students for tuition, registration, examinations or access to laboratory and library facilities. Nevertheless, they may be charged small fees on the same basis as local students for costs such as insurance, student unions and the use of miscellaneous material. Incoming students registered at Iuav for the Double Degree Programme, to obtain the Diploma at the end of the study period, must pay taxes required by Italian Government. (See "During and After the Mobility")
- Provide scholarships to exchange students/staff, if higher education institutions obtain grants from European Union, University Ministries, Public and/or Private organizations. If they receive no grants, the costs of visas, insurance, travel, housing and other costs of life in the foreign country are the student/staff's responsibility.

The higher education institution located in a **partner country** of Erasmus further undertakes to:

#### **Before mobility**

- Provide information on courses (content, level, scope, language) well in advance of the mobility periods, so as to be transparent to all parties and allow mobile students to make well-informed choices about the courses they will follow.
- Ensure that outbound mobile participants are well prepared for the mobility, including having attained the necessary level of linguistic proficiency.
- Provide assistance related to obtaining visas, when required, for incoming and outbound mobile participants. Costs for visas can be covered with the mobility grants. See the information / visa section for contact details.
- Provide assistance related to obtaining insurance, when required, for incoming and outbound mobile participants. The institution from the Partner country should inform mobile participants of cases in which insurance cover is not automatically provided. Costs for insurance can be covered with the organizational support grants. See the information / insurance section for contact details.
- Provide guidance to incoming mobile participants in finding accommodation. See the information / housing section for contact details.

#### **During and after mobility**

- Ensure equal academic treatment and services for home students and staff and incoming mobile participants and integrate incoming mobile participants into the institution's everyday life, and have in place appropriate mentoring and support arrangements for mobile participants as well as appropriate linguistic support to incoming mobile participants.
- Accept all activities indicated in the learning agreement as counting towards the degree, provided these have been satisfactorily completed by the mobile student.
- Provide, free-of-charge, incoming mobile students and their sending institutions with transcripts in English or in the language of the sending institution containing a full, accurate and timely record of their achievements at the end of their mobility period.



- Support the reintegration of mobile participants and give them the opportunity, upon return, to build on their experiences for the benefit of the Institution and their peers.
- To obtain the double degree diploma, incoming students to Iuav are required:
  - to pay taxes required by Italian Ministry of University;
  - to deliver/send a copy of the thesis;
  - to provide for double degree administrative requirements by Iuav University (included Almalaurea)
- To obtain the double degree diploma, incoming students to UChile are required:
  - to pay a graduation degree fee by University of Chile;
  - to deliver/send a copy of the professional internship report and graduation project documentation
  - to provide all administrative requirements for double degree required by University of Chile

### Observation

Students from the UChile who apply to the Laurea Magistrale in Architettura degree at IUAV can prepare their thesis and to pass all courses and ECTS required by IUAV. Once then, they must come back to Chile to accomplish or to validate the professional internship and to enroll the graduation project in validation plan for one semester only. The professional degree obtained at UChile will allow them practicing in Chile, but not in Italy, because the professional license in this country is obtained through a State Exam by an evaluation committee separated from the university.

Students from the IUAV who apply to the Architecture Diploma at UChile will have to pass the seismic structures course, professional internship and to develop and to present a graduation project to a critics committee at UChile. This diploma will allow them practicing in Chile only, thereby they will have to take the State Exam in Italy or in another European country in order to practice on these countries.

Abiding the balance regarding the number of the exchange students, students from UChile and from IUAV who want to apply for NO Double Degree Program, they can attend courses in order to pass exams with credits according to the study plan previously approved by the tutors of both Universities.

### F. Double Degree Study Plan

For each student, a detailed study plan must be approved by both didactic supervisors at IUAV and UCHILE. This plan will not include redundant courses and will be registered in a Learning Agreement. Any modification to the approved plan of study will be registered in the student's change of learning agreement.

If the architecture study plan of any of the institutions involved is modified, it should be opportunely notified to the counterpart in order to determine continuity of the current agreement.



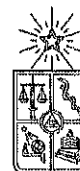

**UCHILE and IUAV are not responsible to find an Institution for the Internship. However, they will provide a list with possible professional studios interested in accepting internships.**

The Double Degree study plan must be completed in one academic year including internship. The host university reserves the right to suspend the enrolment at the Double Degree Programme to a student with deficient academic results. In the case that one student fails one or more courses, he/she should return and finish his/her courses at the home university. All courses and credits accumulated by the student at the host university will be recognized at the home university.

UCHILE Double Degree students (hosted at Iuav) will discuss their thesis at the Home University and the discussion might be done through skype connection between the universities. After discussion, Iuav will receive from UCHILE the certificate of the degree and the final Transcript of Records, so that Iuav will acknowledge Chilean degree and deliver Italian degree to UCHILE new graduates.

Iuav Double Degree students (hosted at UCHILE) will discuss their graduation project at the Host University and the discussion might be done through skype connection between the universities. After discussion, Iuav will receive from UCHILE the Certificate of Professional Diploma and the final Transcript of Records, so that Iuav will acknowledge Chilean degree and deliver Italian degree to IUAV new graduates.



### G. Students' selection and nomination

Selected students must be nominated by their home University. Then each university will provide the application form and the required additional documents that students must enclose. The additional documents are compulsory and should be enclosed with the application.

Architecture students from UChile who wish to apply for the Laurea Magistrale in Architettura program at Iuav, should apply in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of architecture bachelor, corresponding to the 8<sup>th</sup> semester at UChile, and being awarded with bachelor's degree before starting the exchange program. Architecture students from Iuav who wish to apply for the Diploma of Architecture at UChile, should have completed the Laurea Triennale in Architettura or equivalent studies (above or equal to 180 ECTS).

All applications must be submitted by hardcopy, the host university will review them. Applicants must submit a report with course subjects, original transcript (no photocopies), curriculum vitae, portfolio that includes studio work examples made during bachelor period and a personal statement explaining academic background, motivations and argument that support his/her application. CV and statement documents must be written in host-university language, and the last one must not exceed 500 words length. The acceptance or rejection of the application depends on a review based on academic background, fulfillment of basic requirement established by each institution, motivation and personal commitment towards the program and language level.

3. The receiving institution will send its decision within 8 weeks.

4. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution **no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.**

#### I. Termination of the agreement

This agreement will be in force from the most recent date of its execution, until the expiration date of the Erasmus+ Programme that is the academic year 2020-2021. It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges must be notified to the other party by September 1<sup>st</sup> will only take effect by the following year at September 1<sup>st</sup>. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict".

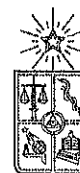

### Grading and credit systems of the institutions

It is recommended that receiving institutions provide the statistical distribution of grades according to the descriptions in the ECTS users' guide<sup>7</sup>. UCHILE	Grades from 1,0 to 7,0 (cum laude), where 4,0 is the minimum passing grade. 1 Chilean credit corresponds to 0,6 ECTS that is 16 hours. For studio, the class schedule dedicates 2/3 for lectures and 1/3 for individual work.




