Rosie Broadhead is a textile designer and researcher specialised in bio-active textiles for fashion industry applications. She is the founder of the material innovation platform SKIN SERIES and a Textile Scientist at Ghent University. Her research focuses on the intersection between skin and clothing, and on understanding the influence on the body through functional materials. The seminar will explore both theoretical and applied research approaches of textiles as therapeutic agents by working at the intersection of science and fashion. Participants are invited to reflect on the relationship between body and textiles surfaces, seen as a whole symbiotic living system.
