Maritime spatial planning (MSP) is an innovative evidence-based approach that focuses on the spatial organization of anthropogenic activities at sea, promoting sustainable development and increasing synergies among maritime activities while limiting environmental interactions.

The 40-hour course, held in English every Monday and Friday, aims at providing knowledge in understanding the MSP process, starting from an ecosystem-based management perspective. An overview of the marine environment features will be introduced, along with a relevant maritime use descriptions, the spatial data representation, and the MSP legal framework.
