Thanks to the support of architects coming from different parts of the world, the structure of OAB is prepared for working in many different contexts, on the permanent understanding that architecture stems from roots that have to do with the tradition of the places one works in and by showing respect towards physical aspects of the location. The internship program at OAB consists of various types of work that contribute to the firm's design projects.	The internship program in this office anticipates the unfolding of various types of work that contributes to the firm's design projects. At first, the interns focus on model making, which is considered an important way to control the evolution of a project. Next, they work on early drawings and finally move on to more developed drawings. Interns also produce presentations for expositions, books or competitions. Model making using various scales and materials. (board, foam board, wood, plastic, soap). Autocad drawings with different levels of detail based on the printing scale. Preparation of presentation boards with Project modifications using Autocad and Adobe Photoshop. Modification of images for presentations and boards. Project presentations created in Microsoft PowerPoint for conferences, expositions, and competitions. Interns have to work with a coordinator, for about one or two days, that provides them with the projects they will be developing within an estimated time, so that the project is always under control. Work on models is usually completed in a group, in order to work on teamwork skills. In the office, it's very important to ask for clarification every time that one does not understand something they are working on. Also, twice a day, the tutor will supervise that the work is on track in order for the Project to be completed in the least possible time.

Backed by a reflection on the relationship between architecture and the specificity of the Canary Islands, the work of Palerm & Tabares de Nava has dealt, over the years, with different scales - architectural, urban and regional projects progressively focusing on the theme of landscape construction, preservation and transformation of the territory.
