Selective procedures for admission to the bachelor's degree programme Design della moda e arti multimediali of the Università Iuav di Venezia for academic year 2026/2027¹

the rector

whereas, following the activation of the study courses and the simultaneous definition of the number programmed for access, by the council of the Department of Culture of the Project, the Academic Senate and the Board of Directors, it is necessary to proceed with the definition of the selective procedures for admission to the bachelor's degree programme in Design della moda e arti multimediali in academic year 2026/2027;

referred to the Statute of the Università Iuav di Venezia;

the University's academic regulations;

drew attention to the internal rules on administrative careers for students at Università Iuav di Venezia;

considering all the laws and subsequent amendments and integrations, indicated in "Procedure selettive per l'ammissione al corso di laurea in Design della moda e arti multimediali dell'Università Iuav di Venezia per l'anno accademico 2026/2027"

obtained the views of the Teaching Coordinator and the Course Coordinator, who expressed their support;

decreed

Article 1 (number of places)

1. Number of places: the pre-application procedure for admission to the **bachelor's degree programme in Fashion Design and Multimedia Arts** (class L-4) is open on available places that, according to the current provisions on the number programmed for admission to university courses, are determined for the academic year 2026/2027 in:

Article 2 (application procedure)

1. Dates and procedures: from the date of publication of this call **until 13:00 on 26 March 2026**, through the **Online Desk** of the Università Iuav di Venezia at <https://iuav.esse3.cineca.it/Start.do>

3. Application options in the same academic year:

- the application of the Bachelor's degree programme in Fashion Design and Multimedia Arts and the the Bachelor's degree programmes in Product Design, Visual Communication and Interior and Design - Vicenza **is not permitted**;
- application **is permitted** for one or maximum two tracks of the degree course in Fashion Design and Multimedia Arts, indicating the order of preference;
- the candidate, if admitted to the interview, will support the interview only for the first choice track;
- You may change your track preferences and order no later than 1:00 PM on April 2, 2026, by sending a written email to info.immatricolazioni@iuav.it

If you wish to update one or more already attached documents, please send an e-mail to the admission service (info.immatricolazioni@iuav.it) and attach the replacement documents.

4. **Payment:** after completing the online application, the candidate must make the payment of € 55.00 by PagoPa **before 13:00 on 26 March 2026**.

5. In order to be admitted to the Bachelor's degree programme, the application must be carried out in accordance with the procedures provided for in this article. The application is not valid in the absence of admission requirements (Art. 3), and is subject to the conduct of the admission test (Art. 4).

5. The **reimbursement of the application fee** is provided only if requested **by 26 March 2026**, the date of receipt of the university protocol is decisive.

Article 3 (admission requirements)

1. The application can be carried out by candidates who **have or who will have before 31 July 2026** one of the following degrees:

- five- or four-year **upper secondary education diploma**;
- **upper secondary education diploma** issued by **foreign institutes and schools**;
- qualifications recognized by the Italian Republic or qualifications awarded by border schools or IB or diplomas awarded by European schools.

2. **Language requirement:** knowledge of **Italian at level B2** (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). The level of language competence can be attested by:

- the presentation of certificates issued by certifying bodies included in the list of accredited entities referred to in the DM of the MUR n. 62 of 10 March 2022 and ss.mm.ii;
- the presentation of certificates issued by the University's Language Centres;
- certification or self-declaration of the passing of exams activated within university study paths (Italian and foreign) that express the direct reference to the CEFR and the level achieved in all dimensions provided for by the framework;
- presentation of the original title or self-declaration relating to upper secondary school degree obtained at the end of a course of studies conducted entirely in Italian language; Self-declared information is subject to verification and takes effect only upon receipt of the confirmation of veracity.

All certificates are valid for 5 years in order to meet the requirements for admission to bachelor's degree courses (excluding the acquisition of the above mentioned degrees).

Article 4 (calendar, methods and contents of the admission test)

1. Access to the degree program is subject to two mandatory tests, the first of which is preparatory for admission to the next test, aimed at ensuring possession of the knowledge required for admission and aptitude for study.
2. Candidates in compliance with the requirements set out in Article 3 who prescribe themselves within the required time limits shall be admitted to the test test.
3. Candidates who rank within position 180 in the first choice track (of which a maximum of 6 non-EU candidates residing abroad per Fashion Design's track) are admitted to the interview, in the first choice track, in descending order of the total score reported on the test. In the event of a tie, the youngest candidate is given priority. The list of those admitted to the interview and the calendar will be published exclusively on the <https://www.iuav.it/it/design-della-moda-e-arti-multimediali/selezioni-immatricolazioni-ammissioni> page by April 21, 2026.
4. The two entrance exams for all candidates are structured as follows:

5. **The multiple choice test** will take place for all candidates **on April 13 at 10:00 a.m.**
6. **The interview** for all those admitted will begin **on April 27th, starting at 9:30**, through the following methods:

The interviews will continue on April 28, 29 and 30, always starting at 9:30 a.m. in the manner indicated above.

The specific location for in-person interviews for the resumes in Communication and New Fashion Media and Fashion Design will be indicated in the interview calendar, available online <https://www.iuav.it/it/design-della-moda-e-arte-multimediali/selezioni-immatricolazioni-admissioni> **from April 21, 2026**.

7. During the tests, candidates may not communicate with each other, or communicate with others, except with members of the supervisory commission or committee. They may not consult textbooks, notes or other sources. Non-compliant candidates are excluded from the test.

8. Candidates benefiting from Law No. 104/92 are guaranteed, upon request, special methods of conducting the test. Candidates suffering from dyslexia (→ Law No. 170/2010 cited in the introduction) are granted, upon request, an additional time equal to 30 percent more than that defined for the tests.

All candidates included in this subparagraph must make any request during the application phase, which must be completed with the upload of the medical certification. The candidate will find details on the support activity and how to participate in the page <https://www.iuav.it/it/design-della-moda-e-arte-multimediali/selezioni-immatricolazioni-admissioni>.

9. The publication of the timetable of examination tests has notification value in all respects. Therefore, candidates are required to present themselves, without any prior notice, in the manner, on the days and at the time indicated in the call and in subsequent notices, equipped with a valid identification document. The absence of the candidate from any of the tests will be considered as a withdrawal of selection, whatever the cause and the reason given.

Article 5 (admission tests for non-EU applicants residing abroad)

1. Non-EU candidates residing abroad will take the admission tests as per the notice referred to in Article 4, paragraph 4.

2. All non-EU candidates residing abroad are required to submit a B2 level Italian language certification as indicated in Article 3, paragraph 2.

3. All non-EU candidates residing abroad will take the admission tests indicated in Article 4, paragraph 4, remotely. They will receive with subsequent notice any minimum indispensable technical requirements and methods of verifying the technical apparatus or identification.

Article 6 (formulation of rankings)

1. The department director appoints one or more **judging committees**, composed of university professors, responsible for conducting the tests. The commissions are supported by a supervisory committee determined by the head of the teaching and student services area.

2. Criteria for evaluating individual tests:

Test	• 1 point for each exact answer • -0.25 points for each wrong answer • 0 points for each answer not given
Colloquio	• exhibition capacity, • communication effectiveness • ability to argue one's interests and the motivations that drive one to undertake studies in the design fields

3. The **final admission rankings**, divided by track and contingent, will be formed according to the order of preference and the total score composed based on the parameters indicated below. Therefore, candidates will be admitted to their first choice

until the available places are filled. Once the first-choice spots are filled, candidates will be admitted to their second choice, retaining the possibility of repechage on their first choice. Admission and/or repechage on the second choice will not be possible if candidates are admitted on the first choice.

The total score is composed as follows:

	Maximum score
Test	60 points
Interview	40 points

In the event of further parity, the **youngest candidate** is given precedence.

4. As indicated in Article 4, paragraph 4, further specifications on the evaluation and scoring criteria will be published with a subsequent notice on the university website.

Article 7 (verification of additional learning requirement)

1. Access to the Bachelor's degree programme in Fashion Design and Multimedia Arts requires adequate initial preparation, gained from previous studies. Therefore, an additional learning requirement (OFA) is assigned to candidates in the ranking in a position suitable for enrollment who do not reach **15 total points out of the 60 available in the test and:**

- **at least 2.25 points in the dimension "3. history of design, history of art and history of architecture".**

The OFA is assigned in:

- "Storia dell'arte contemporanea" for the track in Arti multimediali;
- "Storia della moda" for the track in Design della moda;
- "Culture progettuali contemporanee" for the track in Comunicazione e nuovi media della moda;
- "Storia della moda" for the track in Design dei materiali per la moda.

2. The additional learning requirements will be met by passing a specific test to be carried out before taking the exam of Laboratorio di Basic design: metodi e strumenti; Laboratorio basic design: geometrie e modelli e Storia del design e della tecnica.

Those who fail the additional training requirements by **September 30, 2027**, will be enrolled in the following academic year as a repeating student.

Article 8 (rankings lists and pre-enrollment to the programme)

1. Date of publication of the **ranking list**, deadlines and **pre-enrollment procedures**:

Those who are in a useful position in the ranking but **do not pre-enroll by 20 May 2026 lose their right to enroll and the place is made available for other candidates in descending order of ranking.**

2. **Vacant places:** after the first pre-enrollment period, the number of places still available and the ranking list will be announced **by 22 May 2026**, with a notice published in the official university bulletin and on the website of the Università Iuav di Venezia at <https://www.iuav.it/it/design-della-moda-e-arti-multimediali/selezioni-immatricolazioni-ammissioni>

3. **In addition**, after the publication of guidelines for a. a. 2026/2027, non-EU candidates residing abroad who are in a useful position in the ranking and complete their pre-enrollment, must be submitted to the competent diplomatic missions through the portal **www.universitaly.it** for the issuance of an entry visa for study purposes. Pre-enrollment on University must be made **by 5 june 2026**.

4. The completion of the pre-enrollment procedure in authentication in your personal area replaces the signature of the enrollment form for legal purposes.

Article 9 (enrollment)

1. All non-EU applicants **living abroad** must prove by **31 July 2026** that they have started the visa application procedures, by forwarding to info.immatricolazioni@iuav.it the e-mail requesting the appointment at the Embassy, or any other proof of correspondence with the diplomatic-consular representation.

In the absence of such documentation, the ranking position **will be made available to other candidates respecting the position occupied in the non-EU ranking**.

2. **Timing and enrollment modality for candidates with an Italian diploma** (including those admitted to the vacant places):

3. **Timing and enrollment modalities for applicants holding a foreign degree: from 1 August by 15 October 2026.**

The following documents are required for enrollment finalization:

- **final** diploma in the original language and possible translation into Italian or English (if the original is not already in these languages)
- Certificate of having successfully passed an entry test for higher education in the applicant's home country, if applicable;
- Certificate of school subjects/transcript and possible translation into Italian or English (if the originals are not already in those languages)
- **Italian tax code**

For non-EU applicants residing abroad, the following are also required:

- **Residence permit or** receipt of application for a residence permit
- **Entry visa for study purposes** (University enrollment)

The admission service carries out checks on individual applicants eligible for enrollment and individually requests documents not already provided in the pre-enrollment phase, together with any additional documentation deemed necessary (Declaration of Value, Statement of Comparability and CIMEA Verification, legalization or Apostille etc.)

Enrollment is completed remotely once the individual applicants have submitted complete documentation; you will be asked to view the original paper documentation (by appointment) only in case of impossibility to check the documentation in digital mode.

Please note that completing the pre-enrollment procedure in authentication in your personal area replaces the signature of the enrollment form for legal purposes.

6. In case of non-compliance with the deadlines provided for in this article, applicants lose their right to enroll.

Article 10 (tuition fees)

1. The actual amount of the contribution will be established by subsequent resolution of the bodies of the University. For information purposes, **the amount** relating to the previous academic year (a. a. 2025/26) of **EUR 3011.18** (including stamp and regional tax for the right to study), divided into 3 instalments, of which the first instalment is in turn divided into two instalments as specified in Article 5. The total amount of each instalment shall be determined on the basis of the ISEE and ISPE indicators, of the family to which the candidate belongs and the various forms of benefits are available on the following web page <https://www.iuav.it/it/dirittoallostudio>.

2. The first instalment of the admission fee may be refunded only to non-EU applicants who are resident abroad and whose visa has been refused by diplomatic-consular representations, by sending an e-mail to info.immatricolazioni@iuav.it.

3. Applicants **can not** recover the first instalment, except as provided for in the preceding paragraph.

4. The candidates **graduating**, only and exclusively in case they do not achieve the title, can obtain the refund of the first instalment by sending an email to info.immatricolazioni@iuav.it stating that they have renounced their place/enrollment before July 31, 2026.

5. Graduates and graduating applicants, will not be able to request the reimbursement of the first instalment of the contribution due, whatever the reason for the justification adduced, except as indicated in paragraphs 2 and 4 of this article.

6. For an accurate calculation of tuition fees (see paragraph 1) for a. a. 2026/2027, applicants must complete the self-certification via the Online desk and request the official ISEE for university financial aid.

Article 11 (credit recognition for previous studies)

1. Applicants who have earned university credits in previous registrations can request a career assessment prior to a verification of the abbreviation of career on the new course of study.

2. Specifically, an application may be made by a person who meets the following conditions, provided that the credits obtained were not used to obtain the title used for admission:

- already hold a four- or five-year degree
- is already enrolled in another first level (Bachelor's) programme
- have completed first or second-level university single course units

3. In the case of individual courses held at IUAV, recognition is made following an explicit request by the person concerned as indicated in the subsequent paragraphs of this article.

4. Individual courses supported to meet the curriculum requirements required for admission to the course may not contribute to career shortening.

5. All interested parties must fill out, following the application, the online form on <https://infostudenti.iuav.it/carrierepregresse/>

6. Documents to be attached to the form:

- > for activities carried out in Universities other than IUAV (both Italian and foreign): course programs in pdf format.

Applications without course programmes at other universities will not be considered.

7. Applicants must indicate in the form all examinations taken but also the exams that they intend to take before the actual enrollment to the degree course of this call, with the indication of credits and scientific disciplinary areas.

8. The selection board referred to in Article 4 shall be responsible for evaluating the educational careers received in accordance with paragraphs 5 and 6 of this Article.

9. Applications received during the application phase (by 26 March 2026) will be considered by **14 May**. Applications received after the closing of applications will be examined according to the provisions in the decree "Determination of the number of places in the second and third year of the degree programmes and master's degree programmes activated at the Università Iuav di Venezia and the admission procedures through transfer in entry, internal passage, passage of classification, change of curriculum/address and abbreviation of career - academic year 2026/2027" (published in May).

Article 12 (data protection and access to records)

1. The personal data submitted by candidates with applications to participate in the selective procedure, pursuant to D.lgs. 10/08/2018, n. 101, will be processed exclusively for the purposes of managing this procedure and for any procedures related to university career. The full information on the processing of personal data can be found on the website of Ateneo dedicated to privacy: <https://www.iuav.it/it/privacy>.

2. Candidates may exercise the right of access to the documents of the competition procedure for admission to the master's degree programme referred to in this call according to the procedures provided by D.P.R. of 12 April 2006, n. 184: "Regulation governing access to administrative documents in accordance with Chapter V of Law 241/1990" and the Regulation on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents of the Università Iuav di Venezia.

1.
