Description – The project “**Strengthening Educational Inclusion in Veneto**” (**PROG-541**) aims to strengthen the capacity of schools in Veneto to promote educational and social inclusion programs for pupils and students with a migrant background.

The initiative involves a broad network of schools and regional institutional actors and focuses on strengthening the educational, organizational, and community-based capacities of schools operating in contexts characterized by a significant presence of students of foreign origin.

In this context, the school is viewed not only as a place of formal learning but also as a **local infrastructure** capable of fostering relationships, collaborations, and opportunities within local communities. The project therefore supports strengthening the role of educational institutions as actors capable of engaging with families, local communities, and other stakeholders in educational and social ecosystems.

Through research, training, and the exchange of experiences among schools in the network, the project also aims to **promote and disseminate innovative inclusion practices** capable of countering dynamics of stigmatization and school segregation and of fostering schools that are more open, inclusive, and deeply rooted in the communities where they operate.

Objectives – The project aims to:

- strengthen the processes of **educational inclusion for students from third countries** in schools across the Veneto region;
- combat **stigmatization and educational segregation** linked to the presence of students with a migrant background;
- promote **innovative forms of collaboration between schools and the local community**, involving local stakeholders, families, and communities;
- highlight and disseminate **innovative educational and socio-spatial practices** that improve learning environments both inside and outside of school;
- support **schools’ capacity to act as local stakeholders**, capable of fostering relationships and opportunities within local contexts.
