Dr Răzvan Ion is a university professor of critical thinking, journalist, academic curator, and tech queer activist. He has lead the DerAffe Vienna team in creating A.I. JARVIS, the first artificial intelligence curator in history and has founded GAY45.eu, an award-winning European queer indie journal and queer journalism school.
