**ASSESSMENT OF LANGUAGE KNOWLEDGE**

Iuav organizes a language selection for students applying for the a.y. 2022 - 2023 mobility calls.

The assessment test is scheduled for one of these languages:  
ENGLISH - GERMAN - FRENCH - SPANISH - PORTUGUESE

The candidate must take the language assessment test in the language indicated for the chosen foreign venue specified in the list of partner universities on the Iuav website where the call for applications is published.

A candidate who takes a language test for a language other than the one indicated in the chosen location will receive a lower mark.

Each candidate will be awarded a maximum of 30 points for passing the language test.  
which will be awarded as in the example below:

1. French language test for the French university chosen, passed with sufficient marks, points 20
2. French language test for the French university chosen, passed with good marks, points 25;
3. French language test for the French university chosen, passed with excellent marks, points 30;
4. another language test for the French university chosen, passed with sufficient marks, points 5;
5. another language test for the French university chosen, passed with good marks, points 10;
6. another language test for the French university chosen, with an excellent mark, points 15;
7. insufficient test, points 0
8. test not taken, points -5.

Language tests are organised online by Istituto Zambler di Mestre, Via Forte Marghera n. 27

**The language tests will take place from Thursday 17 February to Thursday 10 March 2022.**

**By Tuesday 8 March 2022, after submitting application via Spin, candidates must book the language test at the Zambler Institute by writing an email to [info@istitutozambler.com](mailto:info@istitutozambler.com)**

**In the e-mail requesting registration for the language test, the student must specify:**

- surname and name;**
- Iuav registration number (matricola);**
- mobile number;**
- if your application is for Erasmus call or for NON Erasmus Call (non European Universities)**
- foreign language in which to take the test**

Only one e-mail from the student is admissible; requests to change the language in which the test is to be taken will not be accepted. It is the student's responsibility to choose the location and the foreign language for which he/she requests mobility and language assessment respectively.

After receiving the request, Zambler Institute will contact the student and arrange an appointment to take the language test, sending an email indicating the date and time.

On the day and at the time regarding the booking of the test, the candidate will show the Zambler Institute an identity document for identification and the printing regarding the application for a mobility place.
